KEEPING THE FAITH

LIFE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- A. What Paul believed was important in his life (2 Timothy 4:6-7 CSB)
 - 1. He did not talk about the churches planted or people reached
 - 2. Fought a good fight likened his life for the Lord as a fight
- B. Barnabus gives insight as to what is required to keep the faith (Acts 11:23 NKJV)
 - 1. He saw God's grace as people came to Christ
 - 2. He encouraged the believers to make a heart decision
 - 3. Keeping the faith is staying true to a person, not a religion

DANIEL'S DECISION

- A. Forced into an environment that had no respect for God
 - 1. King Nebuchadnezzar from Babylon besieged and captured Jerusalem
 - 2. Daniel and friends were given an opportunity to have a better life (Daniel 1:3-7 NKJV)
 - 3. There was a catch abandon the faith, the ways of God
- B. Daniel purposed in his heart to continue to live for his God (Daniel 1:8, 12-16 NKJV)
 - 1. This decision was not about food quality but his relationship with God
 - 2. Requested a ten day test not demanding or blasting Babylonian culture
 - 3. Not the easy path eating veggies for three years
- C. God honored Daniel and friends (Daniel 1:17, 19-20 NKJV)
 - 1. Gave them knowledge and what they needed to excel
 - 2. Caused them to stand out they honored God, He got involved in their lives

KEEPING THE FAITH REQUIRES PURPOSE OF HEART

- A. Purpose to not let your environment diminish your God make Him smaller to you
 - 1. You may be in a situation where there is no respect for God or your faith in Him
 - 2. Daniel's secret he prayed three times a day
 - 3. Purpose is to pray and read your Bible regularly (Psalms 34:3 NKJV)
- B. Purpose to live clean before God
 - 1. What you consume take in
 - 2. What you do the way you live your life
 - 3. Living clean is living strong (Hebrews 12:1-2 CSB)
- C. As you purpose in your heart to keep the faith you honor God, and He will honor you
 - 1. He will get involved in your life
 - 2. This is not the easy path, but it's the best one
