#### Text: Romans 10:8-10 NKJV

### THE HEART AND MOUTH PRINCIPLE

- Started with Israel in the Old Testament (Deuteronomy 30:11-15 NKJV)
  - 1. God's Word is not too high and lofty
  - 2. Not too far off
  - 3. God's Word is very near you

# GIDEON'S EXAMPLE (Judges 6:11-16 NKJV)

- The Lord's perspective of Gideon
  - 1. The Lord was with him
  - 2. Gideon was a mighty man of valor
  - 3. He was to go in his might and save Israel
  - 4. The Lord was sending him
  - 5. The Lord was with him (repeat)
  - 6. He will defeat the Midianites
- Gideons' perspective
  - 1. If the Lord is with us, then why all these troubles?
  - 2. If the Lord is with us, then where are the miracles?
  - The Lord has forsaken us and delivered us to the Midianites
  - 4. He was from a family with no prestige or standing
  - 5. He was the least in his family the least of the least
- God speaks to Gideon again (Judges 7:9-11 NKJV)
  - 1. God said He had delivered the Midianites into Gideon's hand
  - 2. But fear would hold him back so go hear what the enemy says
  - 3. Hearing would cause strength to come
- Gideon gets it right (Judges 7:12-15 NKJV)
  - 1. The enemy was saying the same things God was saying
  - 2. Gideon worshipped God for the answer before he saw it
  - 3. Gideon agrees with God and says the same thing
